Grass

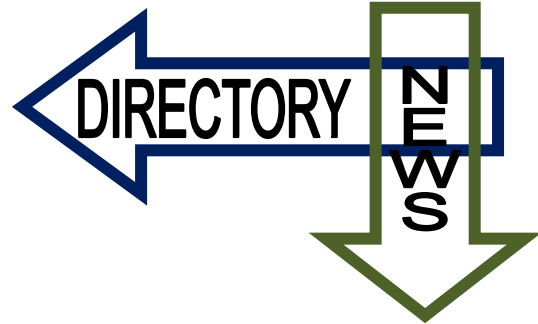

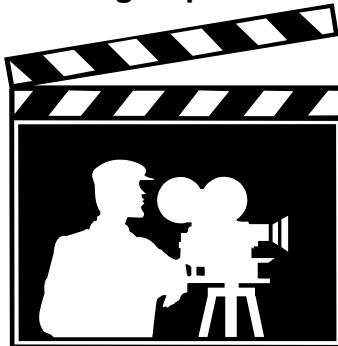

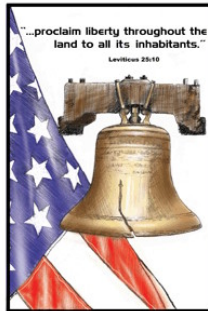
